

Atherstone Surgery Information

Two GP's at Atherstone Surgery have today been advised by Public Health England to self-isolate after being in contact with patients who have tested positive for Corona Virus. Both Dr Thomson and Dr Davies are non-symptomatic and neither wanted to leave the surgery today. Please be re-assured that any patient who has seen either Dr Thomson or Dr Davies are not at risk as neither doctors are showing any symptoms.

We are currently in the process of trying to change face to face appointments with clinicians to telephone triage appointments where at all possible. We are also delaying any non-urgent routine appointments to a later date. We will be contacting patients as soon as possible to put this into place.

This will also mean that we will be cancelling face to face open surgery for the next few weeks and will deal with phone slots only for the clinician to decide if an appointment is necessary or not.

We are constantly monitoring the Corona Virus situation and will keep our patients updated as soon as we can.
